Play will be as follows:

- a. Round Robin two game matches in each pool will be played. 25 point (no cap) will be used in the pool play games. We will start at 6pts.
- b. Round Robin won-loss record will determine the winner and second place positions in each pool.
- c. Round Robin two game matches in each pool will be played. 25 point (no cap) will be used in the pool play games. We will start at 6pts.
- d. Round Robin during round robin play for the teams involved in the tie.
- e. If a tie continues to exist, a point differential between the teams involved in the tie will be used to determine the teams' positions.  
*Exception for 2nd place tie: a team will not be eliminated from participation in the semi-final matches due to point differential. A 2nd and 3rd place team will play one 15 pt. rally game if still tied after (d) head-to-head competition in pool play.*
- a. If a tie continues to exist for 1st place, a point differential for total tournament play will be used to determine the teams' positions.
- f. If a tie still exists for 1st place, the tie will be broken with a coin flip.
- g. Semi-final and final matches will be two out of three games.
